Applying to WPI

You may apply to WPI using our customized WPI application as well as the Common Application (www.commonapp.org) or the Universal Application (www.universalcollegeapp.com). We accept both online and paper versions of each.

Just to ease your mind, we want you to know that we don't have a preference for which application you use, but please submit only one application. Applying with two different types of applications will result in two application records, which will delay the admissions process.

If you apply to WPI directly through the WPI Web site you can use the Login ID and PIN you create to view your application status.

If you apply with a paper application, or with an online Common or Universal Application, you will receive a Login ID and PIN with your application acknowledgement letter. Please allow two to three weeks for your letter to arrive.

Instructions

FOR ALL CANDIDATES:

1. Complete the entire application. Please type or print clearly.
2. Type or print all personal information on any forms (download at admissions.wpi.edu/application.html) prior to distributing.
 - a. Submit the "Math/Science Faculty Recommendation," along with a stamped envelope addressed to WPI's Office of Admissions, to a math, biology, chemistry, or physics teacher/professor who had you in class.
 - b. Submit the "Transcript Request Form" to your guidance or registrar's office. Please be sure to forward first quarter/semester senior year grades when available.
3. Freshman Candidates should submit SAT or ACT scores or alternative materials through WPI's Flex Path. Candidates choosing to submit test scores must register to take the SAT or the ACT in time for scores to reach WPI by the end of February 2008.

Students who choose WPI's Flex Path may submit alternative materials that they believe will better reflect their potential for success at WPI in lieu of standardized test scores. Students are encouraged to submit examples of academic work or extracurricular projects that reflect a high level of organization, motivation, creativity and problem-solving ability. Any significant work undertaken independently or in school that the applicant believes is an appropriate reflection of his or her academic potential will be an appropriate submission. The Flex Path supplement (admissions.wpi.edu/supplement) must also be submitted.

Submissions will be evaluated for one or more of the following: creativity, problem solving ability, initiative, motivation, leadership, academic ability, technical skill, team work and social commitment.

5. Your personal statement may accompany this application or be sent separately by mail or e-mail (admissions@wpi.edu).

All applicants will automatically receive an acknowledgment letter to indicate receipt of application by WPI's Office of Admissions. Please take particular note as to what may be missing in order to complete your admission folder. Applicants will also receive instructions on how to monitor application status online.

FOR EARLY ACTION CANDIDATES:

1. Check the Early Action box on page 1 and on the recommendation and transcript forms.
2. If admitted, Early Action candidates have until May 1, the Candidate's Reply Date, to make an enrollment decision.

FOR FIVE-YEAR BS/MS CANDIDATES:

1. As you complete the Program/Area of Study section of the application, be sure to also identify your interest in either mathematics or fire protection engineering.
2. You will be notified, in writing, about your eligibility for the BS/MS program within four to six weeks of your admission to WPI. Notification will be sent directly from the Mathematical Sciences Department or the Fire Protection Engineering Department.

FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. In addition to completing the application, international students must submit the following documents:
 - An official, certified record of secondary school work with all courses and grades (results) listed.
 - An explanation of the grading system used and an English translation of any records in languages other than English.
 - A Statement of Financial Responsibility (in English and with appropriate signatures) and bank or sponsor verification indicating ability to meet WPI's annual cost. (The WPI Certification of Finances Form is available at admissions.wpi.edu.)
If you are applying for financial aid, this form must be submitted by March 1.
2. If English is not your native language, one of the following must be taken in addition to the exams mentioned in #3 of the "all candidates" instructions (see inside front cover of this application):
 - TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language)
 - IELTS (International English Language Testing System)
3. Please be sure to include an e-mail address so we may update you on your status.
4. Please be sure to update your mailing address throughout the year.

FOR TRANSFER CANDIDATES

1. You must submit official transcripts of all work completed at the college level, as well as a listing of courses in progress. Mid-semester grades for all transfer candidates are required and a form will be mailed to each transfer student upon receipt of the WPI application.
2. If you have graduated from high school within the last year or have completed fewer than three college semesters, please have your high school transcript sent to WPI.
3. If your formal education has been interrupted for a year or more, please enclose a statement outlining your activities during that time period.

FOR FINANCIAL AID APPLICANTS (EXCLUDING NON-CITIZENS)

1. You must obtain from your guidance counselor a registration form for the CSS Financial Aid PROFILE. The registration form will be available in October. Submit the completed registration form to the College Scholarship Service.
2. Upon receipt of the PROFILE, please note the submission time frames for Early Action or Regular Decision candidates. Complete the PROFILE and submit it to the College Scholarship Service according to the applicable time frame (profileonline.collegeboard.com).
3. You must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) after January 1 (available at your guidance office in November). Submit the FAFSA to the U.S. Department of Education (fafsa.ed.gov).
